Following the business meeting, we are pleased to welcome Peter Robinson who will explore: "How rental housing projects can demonstrate environmental and economic leadership in small communities."

Residents of both larger urban neighbourhoods, and smaller rural communities, sometimes worry that purpose built rental housing will have a negative impact on their own homes and properties. The perception is that such housing might not reflect community aspirations for environmental performance, appearance, or ongoing operations. Peter Robinson, the former CEO of both the David Suzuki Foundation and BC Housing will speak to why this perception is often wrong, and how small scale rental housing projects can actually be a positive legacy for communities such as Mayne Island.
